2018 CAMP DIRECTOR

RICK SQUIERS has been a head volleyball coach for 28 years including 19 seasons at the University of Nebraska Kearney. To date, he has guided the Lopers to a 604-85 record, 19 NCAA Tournament births, 14 conference championships, three Elite Eight appearances, and a national runner up finish in 2005. A 14-time Coach of the Year, Squiers has coached 34 All-American selections including AVCA National Players of the Year Erin Gudmundson (2005) and Annie Wolfe (2016). Prior to UNK, Squiers served as head coach for nearby Hastings College where he led the Broncos to a 206-59 record and three conference titles in six seasons. Squiers has amassed an overall win loss record of 911-168.

UNK STAFF MEMBERS

KALEIGH ZOUCHA enters her sixth season as assistant coach at the University of Nebraska Kearney after a stellar playing career as Defensive Specialist & Libero. During her playing days, the Lopers earned four Conference Championships and two NCAA Sweet 16 finishes. Kaleigh is also the director of Little Blue Volleyball Academy in Kearney.

STEPH BRAND has completed two seasons as assistant coach at the University of Nebraska Kearney. Her playing career includes a state championship at Grand Island Central Catholic High School, and four trips to the NCAA tournament as a collegian (three for the Lopers). Brand spent the 2015 season as an assistant coach for her alma mater GICC Crusaders, and has several years' experience coaching and directing club volleyball.
