RICK SQUIERS CAMP DIRECTOR



Rick Squiers will begin his twentieth season as UNK head volleyball coach in the fall of 2018. To date, he has guided the Lopers to a 604-85 record which includes nineteen NCAA Tournament births, fourteen conference championships, three Elite Eight appearances, and a national runner up finish in 2005. Squiers has

garnered Coach of the Year honors eleven times at the conference level and four times at the NCAA Regional level. He has coached 33 AVCA All-American selections including National Players of the Year Erin Gudmundson (2005) and Annie Wolfe (2016). Prior to his tenure at UNK, Squiers served as head coach for nearby Hastings College where he led the Broncos to a 206-59 record and three conference titles in six seasons. In 28 seasons as a head volleyball coach, Squiers has amassed a win loss record of 884-171.
