RICK SQUIERS CAMP DIRECTOR



Rick Squiers will begin his 22nd season as UNK head coach and camp director. He has guided the Lopers to a 675-89 record which includes 16 conference championships, 21 NCAA tournament bids, four Elite Eight appearances, and National runner-up finishes in 2005 and 2019. Squiers has coached 37 AVCA All-American selections including National Players of the Year Erin Gudmundson (2005) and Annie Wolfe (2016). Prior to his tenure at UNK he served as head coach for nearby Hastings College where he led the program to a 206-59 record and three conference titles in six seasons. In 30 seasons as a head coach, Squiers has amassed an overall win loss record of 982-182 ranking him in the top ten for both career winning percentage (5th) and career victories among active head coaches (9th).
